MINUTES OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING TUESDAY, MAY 28, 2024 – 9:00 A.M. DETROIT ECONOMIC GROWTH CORPORATION 500 GRISWOLD, SUITE 2200, DETROIT, MI 48226

CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Forte called the meeting of the Finance Committee of the Economic Development Corporation to order at 9:19 a.m. Roll call was conducted, and a quorum was established.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Ms. Forte asked if there were any additions, deletions, or corrections to the minutes of the October 24, 2023 Finance Committee meeting. Hearing none, the Committee took the following action:

Mr. Hodge made a motion approving the minutes of the October 24, 2023 Finance Committee meeting, as written. Mr. Osei seconded the motion. All were in favor with none opposed.

The minutes of the October 24, 2023 Finance Committee meeting were approved.

PROJECTS

EDC Budget for FY 2024-2025

Ms. Kanalos shared the EDC operating budget for FY 2024-2025 which was attached as Exhibit A.

The EDC Finance Committee was asked to recommend the adoption of the EDC operating budget for FY 2024-2025 to the EDC Board of Directors.

Ms. Forte called for questions.

Mr. Hodge asked if the variance between the proposed budget and the actual budget for Motor City Match could be explained. Mr. Long explained that more staff time was needed because of some staff overlapping, and therefore a projected total was given. Mr. Long added that there is variance on both the expense and revenue sides and is a part of the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) contract. Mr. Long concluded that more funds were spent administratively but the net effect on the EDC was negligible.

Ms. Forte called for further discussion. Hearing none, she called for a motion.

Mr. Osei made a motion to approve the EDC Budget for FY 2024-2025, as presented. Mr. Hodge seconded the motion. All were in favor with none opposed.



ADMINISTRATION

OTHER MATTERS

Mr. Osei raised some questions about when ARPA funds need to be fully spent, how the DEGC plans to spend the remaining funds, and how the already spent ARPA funds were used.

Mr. Long responded that all ARPA funds for Motor City Match are projected to be spent by June 30, 2025. Mr. Long stated that to date six million dollars (\$6,000,000.00) of the funds have been spent. Mr. Long stated that three million dollars (\$3,000,000.00) of that total was spent as cash grants, six hundred thousand dollars (\$600,000.00) was spent on restore grants, five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) was spent on technical assistance and about one million six hundred dollars (\$1,600,000.00) was spent administratively, and any funds left over had been spent on events such as Motor City Match awards. Mr. Long advised that he is comfortable with where the ARPA spending is currently.
